Beginning Fingerpicking

Skill Level: Beginning to Intermediate (B-I)

Discover the delicate beauty of fingerpicking your dulcimer. Focus will be on right hand technique and basic fingerpicking patterns through a step-by-step approach using simple exercises to get you started and some lovely music that just begs to be fingerpicked.

Fingerpicking Techniques and Dynamics

Skill Level: Intermediate (I) to High Intermediate (I-A)

For anyone who already fingerpicks, this class will polish and refine your skills. Focus will be on dynamics and "choreographed" picking patterns suitable for harp-style arpeggios as well as alternating bass (Travis style) picking.

International Folk Tunes

Skill Level: Intermediate (I)

Pack your bags and bring your passport! Your musical trip around the world will feature some familiar and not-so-familiar folk tunes from North and South America, Europe, the Mid-East, Asia, and Australia.

Cowboy Tunes

Skill Level: Beginning to Intermediate (B-I)

In DAD tuning, learn a cowboy tune or two each day. Some will be familiar and some not-so-familiar, but all will be geared for fun and ease of playing. Horses, lariats, Stetsons, and boots are optional.
